INFORMATION FOR RETIREES IN NORWAY, DENMARK AND FINLAND

This foundation was created and donated by Marcus Wallenberg, the former Chairman of Atlas Copco, on his 70th birthday 1969. The purpose of the foundation is to provide Atlas Copco/Epiroc employees in Sweden, as well as retirees from the two companies in Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Finland with the opportunity to apply for rehabilitation. Retirees also have the opportunity to apply for contributions for glasses/contact lenses, hearing aids and dental care.

Contribution for glasses/contact lenses, hearing aids and dental care.

Atlas Copco/Epiroc retirees refers to a retiree whose last workplace was a company in the Atlas Copco group or the Epiroc group in Sweden, Norway, Denmark or Finland where the employment must have been full time (100%). By descendants, who must be a retiree, refers to the deceased's husband, wife, or certified cohabitant. Atlas Copco/Epiroc retirees and their descendants can apply for a grant (limited sums) for:

- purchase of glasses/lenses (not glasses subscription)
- hearing aids
- dental expenses

General medical expenses are not covered.

Opportunity to apply to a rehabilitation program



Atlas Copco/Epiroc retirees and their descendants also have the opportunity to apply for rehabilitation grants. This also applies to those of you living in Norway, Finland, and Denmark. However, we want to make you aware that all activities at Svenska Re are conducted in Swedish, and you are responsible for finding out whether a granted subsidy entails taxable benefits for you.

The Foundation is a member of Svenska Re's facility in San Augustin, Gran Canaria, which offers, among other things, rehabilitation for:

- **Rehabilitation Injury and Function**

The program is suitable for you with an orthopedic injury, accidental injuries, post-surgery, osteoarthritis or pain.

- **Mental Health Rehabilitation**

The program is suitable for you with stress-related mental illness such as fatigue syndrome, depression or anxiety.

- **Rehabilitation Illness**

The program may be suitable for you if you need to recover from diseases such as COPD, Covid-19, stroke, MS, cancer treatment, Parkinson's or other diseases.

- **Rehabilitation Rheumatism**

There are two different programs suitable for you with any type of rheumatic diagnosis. During the rehabilitation, you will improve your strength, mobility and fitness as well as gain knowledge about how to manage your life with chronic illness.

- **Rehabilitation Diabetes type 2**

The program is suitable for you who have pre-diabetes (elevated blood sugar) or diagnosed type 2 diabetes. The goal of the program is to achieve a change of lifestyle and to create good new habits with a focus on weight loss.

- **Rehabilitation Heart**

The program is suitable for you who have had a heart attack or have a heart disease. Exercise and a change of lifestyle can make a big difference to health.

- **Rehabilitation Psoriasis**

The program addresses you with psoriasis and offers an individually adapted treatment concept where the objective is a long-term improvement.

The foundation covers the costs of the granted program (which also includes all meals during the rehabilitation period) as well as travel and accommodation during the stay.

A current medical certificate confirming what you are applying for, not older than 6 months at time for application, must be attached to the application. The certificate has to be in English or Swedish.

The board of Foundation of 5 October 1969 meets twice a year, in spring and autumn. The Board of Directors includes representatives of the company management and members of the employee organizations.

The application is made by you personally or a representative appointed by you.

Please notice: If you are an applicant from Norway, Denmark or Finland must register your application on the English-language pages when you click on the application link below. Some tips to keep in mind so that your application can proceed in the application process:

- When applying for a grant for dental care, glasses/contact lenses or a hearing aid, some form of proof of payment must be attached to the application. This may be a receipt or an invoice with a payment confirmation from the bank. It may also be a cost estimate, for example for dental care. A receipt may not be issued before the date of retirement.
- Since you no longer need to submit your original receipts with the application, a receipt may be at most 6 months old at the time of application if you have previously applied for a grant from the foundation, and at most 2 years old if this is your first application.
- A receipt attached to the application must be issued to you as the applicant and contain information about the supplier's name, date, amount and what the payment concerns. If your name is not stated, the receipt must be supplemented with a payment confirmation from the bank showing that you are the one who made the payment. A card slip alone is not sufficient as documentation. In all other respects, please refer to the Swedish Tax Agency's rules.
- An application may only concern one purpose: dental care **or** glasses/contact lenses **or** hearing aid. You may submit one application per purpose and application period.
- Provide an email address that you or a person appointed by you checks regularly.
- Make sure that all mandatory information in the form has been completed.
- If you are not able to submit a digital application yourself, you may get help from a representative appointed by you who has BankID. If you do not have access to a computer, BankID or anyone who can apply on your behalf, please contact the Foundation's administrator PRI Pensions- och stiftelsetjänst AB:
